**EATING & DRINKING**

<b>Large Tin Plate</b>	With flowers in a vase decoration. For communal eating – staple food injera, a large flat bread.		
<b>Small Tin Plate</b>	With yellow and green decoration in 4 parts		
<b>Metal Drinking Cup</b>	Decorated with a blue lion.		
<b>Metal Pouring Vessel</b>	With long handle and pouring spout. (adding water to coffee pot)		
<b>Metal Pan</b>	With long handle for roasting coffee beans.		
<b>Miniature Stove</b>	Three pieces. Used with charcoal to prepare coffee		
<b>Full-sized Coffee Pot</b>	Silver metal with round base.		
<b>Coffee Pot Stand</b>	Painted green with white and red dots.		
<b>4 Coffee Cups</b>	Porcelain – made in china.		
<b>Large Palm Leaf Mat</b>	Used to turn over large injera (pancake)		

**HOUSEHOLD ITEMS**

<b>Brush</b>	Made of palm for sweeping floors.		
<b>Goat Skin Rug</b>	For wall decoration. Decorated with lady in green shawl – marked 'Bilen Eritrea'. Bilen is 1 of the 9 languages spoken in Eritrea.		
<b>Christmas Star Mat</b>	Made with foil food wrappers and sewn on to a raffia mat.		
<b>3 Mats</b>	For fanning a fire or used as wall decorations.		
<b>2 Shopping Bags</b>	Cotton fabric. One with Arabic writing, one with Eritrea & a camel. Eritrea has banned plastic carrier bags		

**DECORATIVE ITEMS**

<b>Pink/Purple Pot &amp; Lid</b>	Hand made.		
<b>Perfume Bottle &amp; Cap</b>	Toy decorated with pink & white plastic and small gold balls.		
<b>Basket</b>	Toy made from red velvet.		
<b>Coffee Pot &amp; Stand</b>	Toy made from red velvet.		
<b>Plastic Basket</b>	Toy decorated with small gold balls.		

**CLOTHES**

<b>School Bag</b>	White cotton.		
<b>2 Pairs Boy's Sandals</b>	Black.		
<b>2 Boy's Hats</b>	Embroidered with Islamic patterns.		
<b>3 Djellabahs</b>	Pale blue cotton.		
<b>2 Child's Dresses</b>	Coloured patterns.		
<b>1 Girl's Headscarf</b>	Pink		

**MUSIC**

<b>2 Miniature Drums</b>	Covered with hide and decorated with figures of musicians.		
<b>1 K'ra</b>	5 Stringed instrument with a small drum attached.		
<b>Cassette Tape</b>	Cover shows man in wheel-chair.
