<b>Sieve</b>	South Africa.		
<b>2 x Bags</b>	1 x Plastic carrier bag, stripped black, blue, green and yellow (South Africa). 1 x light green plastic carrier bag (Ethiopia)		
<b>Banana Fibre Box</b>	South Africa.		
<b>Newspaper Logs x 2</b>	UK but similar are used across a number of countries especially South Africa.		
<b>Grass Place Mats</b>	Bangladesh.		
<b>Paper Set</b>	Hand made (India). 1 x large salmon coloured bag containing: 1 x card; 1 x notepad; 1 x marbled sheet of paper approx. A4; 10 x pink sheets of paper approx. A4; 2 x small, thick paper sheets; 12 x envelopes; 1 x small paper bag showing palm tree; 1 x small, marbled paper bag.		
<b>Glass Bottle</b>	Used as a storage container for other than the original contents		
<b>Picture</b>	Made from locally found materials: reeds, grass, palm leaves and thread from woven sacks, wood (Ghana/Zambia).		
<b>Shallow Basket</b>	Made from reclaimed wire, covered with locally found grass, wrapped in thread from woven sacks (Zambia). Similar baskets are made across a number of African countries, especially Uganda.		
<b>Fan</b>	Indonesia.		
<b>Waste + 7Rs</b>	A folder of classroom activities.		
<b>Shout About Waste</b>	Educational pack for ages 11-13.		
<b>Family Life + 5Rs</b>	Reduce, Reuse, Refill, Repair, Recycle.
